Date	Activity
Monday, June 22	With your family, solve Miss Marle's word problem: From September to June we were at school for 28 weeks. We had 2 weeks off for Winter Break. There were 4 holidays and 4 pro. d. days. How many days were we at school this year?
Tuesday, June 23	With your family, solve Miss Marle's word problem: We did 12 weeks of home learning. Three days were holidays (Good Friday, Easter Monday and Victoria Day). We also had two Pro. D. Days. How many "Home Learning" days were there?
Wednesday, June 24	Calculate the total number of school days this year. You'll need your answer from Monday's question and your answer from yesterday's questions. Miss Marle's answers are at the end of this document.
Thursday, June 25	Create your own math word problem! Ask a family member to solve it and/or post your word problem on Flipgrid. Watch your peers' videos on Flipgrid. Try to answer at least 3 questions.

Word Problems: Answers

Monday's Question:

From September to June we were at school for 28 weeks. We had 2 weeks off for Winter Break. There were 4 holidays and 4 pro. d. days.

How many days were we at school this year?

$$28 \text{ weeks} - 2 \text{ weeks of Winter Break} = 26 \text{ weeks}$$

$$26 \text{ weeks} \times 5 \text{ days a week} = 130 \text{ days}$$

$$130 \text{ days} - 4 \text{ holidays} = 126 \text{ days}$$

$$126 \text{ days} - 4 \text{ Pro. D. days} = 122 \text{ days}$$

122 days

Tuesday's Question:

We did 12 weeks of home learning. Three days were holidays (Good Friday, Easter Monday and Victoria Day). We also had two Pro. D. Days. The last week of school (June 19 – 25) is only a 4 day week.

How many "Home Learning" days were there?

$$12 \text{ weeks} \times 5 \text{ days} = 60 \text{ days}$$

$$60 \text{ days} - 3 \text{ holidays} = 57 \text{ days}$$

$$57 \text{ days} - 2 \text{ Pro. D. Days} = 55 \text{ days}$$

$$55 \text{ days} - 1 \text{ day} = 54 \text{ days}$$

54 days

Wednesday's Question:

Calculate the total number of school days this year. You'll need your answer from Monday's question and your answer from yesterday's questions.

$$122 \text{ days} + 54 \text{ days} = 176 \text{ days of school}$$

176 days
